Park and Pay Spaces

Park for a maximum of 1-2 hours for \$2/hour. Effective July 1, 2019, the permit fee will increase to \$4/hour. Purchase a permit in the following locations:

Location	# of Spaces	Maximum Time Limit
College Park South First full row behind College Park	27	1 Hour
South Campus Drive Dan Black Hall, near Langsdorf Hall	19	1 Hour
Resident Hall Lot East of Student Housing	9	2 Hours
Gym Drive North of Student Health Center	14	1 Hour
TSU South of Titan Student Union	13	1 Hour
Eastside Structure Ground level, north side of structure	76	2 Hours
State College Structure Ground level, east of structure	57	2 Hours
Nutwood Structure Ground level, northeast side of structure	18	2 Hours

Daily Parking

- Park for the entire day for \$8 in all student lots and structures (unless restricted) and the Irvine Campus student lots. Effective July 1, 2019, the permit fee will increase to \$10.
- After 4 p.m., permits are valid in the Faculty/Staff spaces in College Park. After 6 p.m., permits are valid in Faculty/Staff Lots A and E, C-West, and C-East.
- Purchase a Daily Permit Online through the Parking & Transportation Services page, at one of the three Visitor Information Centers on campus, or at a permit machine in Lots A, D, G, S, Arts Drive and levels two and above of the Nutwood, State College, and Eastside Parking Structure. Visitor Disabled Placard (DP) Parking

Campus visitors may park in any designated disabled space, without paying the user fee, if it is their first visit to the university. After the first visit, the disabled placard must be displayed with a valid CSUF parking permit.
